Location

The meeting will take place in the Rosalind Franklin Pavilion, Hinxton Hall Conference Centre, Wellcome Trust Genome Campus, Hinxton, Cambridge CB10 1SD.

Travelling to the Wellcome Trust Genome Campus, Hinxton

The closest airports to the Wellcome Trust Genome Campus are London Stansted Airport (30 minutes from here), London City Airport and Luton Airport (both 50 minutes from here). Heathrow and Gatwick are both more than 2 hours from Hinxton by car (3 to 4 hours by public transport). Consequently, we advise you to book a flight that lands in London Stansted, London Luton or London City Airport. EasyJet, Ryanair and Virgin Express all land in Stansted and fly from most larger European cities.

Please be aware that we do not recommend you travelling to Whittlesford or Great Chesterford unless you pre-book a taxi – there are no taxi ranks at those stations and it is difficult to obtain a taxi at short notice. Prices for taxis are approximately as follows: Heathrow to Hinxton GBP 80; Luton - Hinxton GBP 50; London City - Hinxton GBP 60; Stansted - Hinxton GBP 25; Cambridge to Hinxton GBP 15; Audley End to Hinxton GBP 12

Accommodation

Catering

A sandwich lunch will be provided every day from Monday 1 to Saturday 6 December.

No catering has been organised in the evenings. Please note that the only options locally are the Red Lion in Hinxton, 5 minutes walk from campus and the Ickleton Lion in Ickleton, 20 minutes walk from campus. We shall organise a shuttle bus between Cambridge and Hinxton every evening from Monday 1 to Friday 5 December included – please see the section on shuttle bus.

On **Sunday evening** we shall make a reservation with the Red Lion, Hinxton, for those of you who wish to have dinner locally – please state this on your registration form.

Shuttle buses

Every evening from Monday 1 to Friday 5 December there will be a shuttle bus going to Cambridge City Centre – it will leave from the Conference Centre, Hinxton at 19.00. The return shuttle bus will leave Cambridge City Centre at 22.00.
