## 1 Overall quality at a glance (i)

• Molecule 1 is a protein called Protocadherin-1.

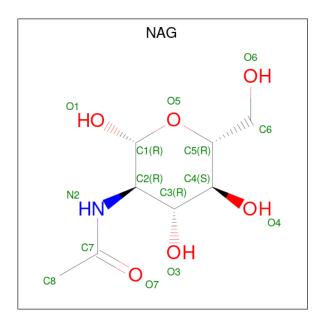



Xtriage's analysis on translational NCS is as follows: The largest off-origin peak in the Patterson function is 3.57% of the height of the origin peak. No significant pseudotranslation is detected.

The Link column lists molecule types, if any, to which the group is linked. The Z score for a bond



length (or angle) is the number of standard deviations the observed value is removed from the expected value. A bond length (or angle) with |Z| > 2 is considered an outlier worth inspection. RMSZ is the root-mean-square of all Z scores of the bond lengths (or angles).
